Types of Adverbs

Adverb of Time

The results were announced **yesterday**.

She will visit the hospital **tomorrow**.

Adverb of Place

They will meet you **there**.

In spring, flowers bloom **everywhere**.

Adverb of Manner

He **quietly** slipped away.

She works **fast**.

Adverb of Frequency

He likes to watch TV **every day**.

They meet **every week**.

Adverbs of Degree

She **almost** finished the work.

They were **completely** surprised by the windfall.

Adverbs of Confirmation and Negation

They will **certainly** like this vase.

He **never** leaves his house.

Adverbs of Comment

They found his secret **easily**.

**Unfortunately**, they found his secret easily.

**Luckily**, the dog did not bite the children.

**Happily**, the power returned before the big match.

Did he **honestly** expect me to lie for him?

And they would win the world cup, **obviously**.

He was going for an important interview; **accordingly**, he made sure that he reached on time.
